CHURCHES QUIZ – SATURDAY 13th February 2021

Quiz starts at 7:00PM

(Please join the Zoom session by around 6:50pm)

Please download and print this page as a reference for the evening. We need everyone to be clear how the quiz will work and avoid long verbal explanations.

Download a copy of our <u>church newsletter</u> for the 3rd February; this will include a link to the quiz Zoom session. If you have not used Zoom before it would be useful to have already have installed their software (available at <u>www.zoom.us</u>).

It will be easier if you have laptop / desktop computer rather than an iPad / Tablet.

On the quiz evening, please connect to the Zoom session around 6:50pm – if you have not joined by 7pm you may not be able to join in the rest of the evening.

On connecting to the Zoom session, we will welcome you, and then swiftly mute your sound. This is to avoid a lot of noise as people fill the screens.

You need to enable the 'Chat' area in Zoom – which should display to the right of the zoom window. We will then allocate you into teams (it does not matter how many people are at each screen). At this point you will not know who is in your team.

At 7pm we will send you a file that tells you what to do next – this will be sent via the 'Chat' feature. You need to open this file and read the content.

You will then be moved into your teams for about 10 minutes to:

- Make a note of the Breakout Team Number you move in to.
- Introduce yourselves to each other.
- Choose a team name
- Select a scorer (this needs to be the same person for all rounds)
- Decide if you want to use your 'Joker' for the first round or for a later round.

Everyone will then exit from their teams; each nominated scorer will then be asked to provide the the name of their team, **and quickly introduce the members of their team.**

For each round of the quiz:

- Everyone will be sent the questions via 'Chat' in a PDF file.
- You will be sent into your pre-define teams.
- You then have about 8 minutes to write down your answers.
- You will be given 1-minute notice for the end of the round.
- The answers to the round will be spoken to everyone.
- Scorers will be asked to report their scores.
